## **Editorial Publishing Policies**

The following editorial and publishing policies apply to content the JASIT Publication Charges

## 1. Article Processing Charges (APC)

**Fees and discounts.** To provide open access, JASIT uses a business model in which expenses including those of peer review, journal production, and online hosting and archiving are recovered in part by charging a journal-specific **publication fee** to the authors for each article they publish. Authors who have registered as an **Annual member of the Prakriti Mitra Society for Science & Technology will discount in APC for a period of 1 year**. APC for each accepted article is **Rs. 1500/100 USD, it will** covers part of the handling expenses and thus entirely non-refundable. APC does not bind the journal to be listed by a professional body or agency/ or being indexed in a database.

## 2. Open Access Agreement.

Upon submission of an article, the authors are asked to indicate their agreement to abide by an open access **Creative Commons license (CC-BY)**. Under the terms of this license, authors retain ownership of the copyright of their articles. The license permits any user to download, print out, extract, reuse, archive, and distribute the article, so long as appropriate credit is given to the authors and source of the work. The license ensures that the authors' article will be available as widely as possible and that the article can be included in any scholarly archive.

## 3. Submission of related manuscripts

During the submission of an article, all authors are asked to indicate that they do not have a related or duplicate manuscript under consideration (or accepted) for publication elsewhere. Reviewers will be asked to comment on the overlap between related submissions.

# 4. Confidentiality

Editors and reviewers are required to treat all submitted manuscripts in strict confidence. The names and email addresses entered in this journal site will be used exclusively for the stated purposes of this journal and will not be made available for any other purpose or to any other party.

## 5. Corrections and Additions

Responsibility for the accuracy of content lies with the author(s) of the paper. Any corrections or updates to an article after publishing will be accepted at an additional charge of INR 500/USD 50.

### 6. Publication Ethics/Plagiarism

Authors are expected to be aware of, and comply with, best practice in publication ethics specifically with regard to authorship (for example avoidance of ghost or guest authorship), dual submission, plagiarism, manipulation of figures, competing interests and compliance with policies on research ethics. Author must submit plagiarism report by using **iThenicate/Turnitin software** as supplementary materials. Reviewers and Editors are required to treat manuscripts fairly and in confidence.

#### **Role of the Corresponding Author**

**One author** is assigned as Corresponding Author and acts on behalf of all co-authors and ensures that questions related to the accuracy or integrity of any part of the work are appropriately addressed.

The Corresponding Author is responsible for the following requirements:

- ensuring that all listed authors have approved the manuscript before submission, including the names and order of authors;
- managing all communication between the Journal and all co-authors, before and after publication;\*
- providing transparency on re-use of material and mention any unpublished material (for example manuscripts in press) included in the manuscript in a cover letter to the Editor; making sure disclosures, declarations and transparency on data statements from all authors are included in the manuscript as appropriate

#### **Changes to authorship**

Authors are strongly advised to ensure the correct author group, the Corresponding Author, and the order of authors at submission. Changes of authorship by adding or deleting authors, and/or changes in Corresponding Author, and/or changes in the sequence of authors are **not** accepted **after acceptance** of a manuscript.

• Please note that author names will be published exactly as they appear on the accepted submission!

Please make sure that the names of all authors are present and correctly spelled, and that addresses and affiliations are current.
